Call for Graduate Student Papers

The Rice University Global Paris Center and the Mathematical Economics and Applied Microeconomics Laboratory (LEMMA) at Paris-Panthéon-Assas University will host the 2024 Rice-LEMMA Monetary Conference in Paris, France on Thursday & Friday, May 16-17th, 2024.

The conference aims to bring together researchers working on topics in monetary economics, liquidity, banking, and financial markets, all defined broadly. The first day of the conference will consist of Ph.D. student presentations with discussants while the second day will consist of presentations by faculty or other researchers. The conference will take place at the Rice Global Paris Center, 5 Rue Sainte-Croix de la Bretonnerie in le Marais neighborhood in Paris, France.

Submission deadline: Ph.D. students interested in presenting at the conference should submit a full paper by **February 1st, 2024** to <u>rice.lemma.monetary@gmail.com</u>. The conference will cover 3 nights of hotel for all graduate student presenters. Additionally, we provide travel reimbursement for flights up to \$1,200 USD for non-European-based presenters and reimbursement for travel expenses up to \$200 for European-based presenters. Authors chosen to present will be notified by late February 2024.
